2016 Tricky Tray Class Basket Themes

Pre-School

- **Mrs. Visotsky – Fun with Play Dough** (play dough, all play dough related items, etc.)

Kindergarten

- **Mrs. Rallo – Rise & Shine** (coffee maker, tea pot, mugs, waffle maker, toaster, tea, coffee, sugar, filters, pancake mix, jellies, syrup, To-Go cups etc.)
- **Ms. Benson – Kiss the Cook** (pots, pans, crock pot, dishes, glasses, garbage can, towels, apron, pot holders, serving utensils, etc.)
- **Mrs. Gaudreau – Gone Fishin'** (tackle box, pole, lures, fishing hat, hooks, bobbers, bug spray, etc.)

First Grade

- **Ms. Mahoney & Ms. Carpen – Gardener's Paradise** (tools, seeds, gloves, basket, watering can, flower pots, Miracle Grow, Yard Guard, garden flags, etc.)
- **Ms Davis – BBQ Time** (grill, tools, apron, sauces, rubs, citronella candles, food nets, skewers, etc.)
- **Mrs. Geissel – Italian Lovers** (pasta maker, colander, cheese grater, various pastas, sauces, pizza cutter, pizza board, wines, glasses, etc.)

Second Grade

- **Mrs. Lesler – A Day at the Beach** (cooler, towels, toys, chairs, umbrella, sun block, beach bag, boogie board, etc.)
- **Mrs. Peschl – Movie Night** (DVD/Blu Ray player, movies, blanket, snacks, popcorn, etc.)
- **Mrs. Duhaime – Namaste!** (yoga matt, towels, DVDs, herbal tea, candles: everything to help someone obtain calm and peace in their life. Maybe a local yoga studio would be willing to donate a session?)

Third Grade
